Decide when, how, and what to give.

Make your gift now or provide for Dairy Shrine in your will or trust agreement. Almost any kind of asset can be a gift, including cash, publicly traded securities, real estate, life insurance, personal property, and private foundation assets. Talk with your tax or estate-planning advisor to determine what's right for you. Dairy Shrine has a history of responsible stewardship of all funds.

Unrestricted funds support general operations of Dairy Shrine, including scholarships, awards, museum exhibits, receptions, membership recruitment, The Chronicle newsletter, and website.
